

Northern Pismo Beach

The Northern Pismo Beach area runs from the north end of Shell Beach to Dinasa Park in the south. This area is primarily moderately dense residential, especially along the coastline. This area has relatively high cliffs which will likely take the majority of the impact of any tsunami, but there are a few select areas which will likely have a damaging impact to structures.
