

North Coast

The North Coast area contains the area between San Simeon and Monterey County border. This area is remote and relatively undeveloped, and includes Old San Simeon. No inundation area was generated north of Point Piedras Blancas. Use the 50' elevation line as a reference, although no significant damage is expected from Point Piedras Blancas to the county line, even with the largest of tsunamis.
